

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2004-2024 ORDINANCE

TOWN OF ELLINGTON

Outagamie County, Wisconsin

An Ordinance to Adopt the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Ellington, Outagamie County, Wisconsin.

The Town Board of the Town of Ellington Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to section 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Ellington is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town of Ellington, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission of the Town of Ellington, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Ellington", containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 4. The Town of Ellington has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.


SECTION 5. The Town Board of the Town of Ellington, Outagamie County Wisconsin, does by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Town of Ellington Outagamie County, Wisconsin Comprehensive Plan 2004-2024", pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication and/or posting as required by law.
